A GUIDE TO A HEALTHY STAY IN PARADISE

Oyster Bay Beach Resort and Coral Beach Club have instituted new health and safety policies for the protection of our guests and staff.



Your temperature will be taken upon arrival, and daily through the duration of your stay, with a no-touch thermometer. Those with a temperature lower than 100.4 °F will be issued a color coded wrist band to be displayed while on resort property.



In the event that you have a temperature of 100.4 °F or higher, or develop other symptoms, we will request that you restrict your movements to your room(s) and balcony until there is a determination made concerning your health status. We will retest your temperature, and if conditions persist, will assist you with accessing a medical doctor to evaluate your health.



We have established a social distancing protocol throughout the resort. Additionally, face masks will be required in all common areas of the resort where social distancing cannot be maintained. Face masks will not be required in the dining room, by the pool or on the beach. All staff will be wearing face masks and other additional PPE that may be required by their jobs, and will practice social distancing as well.



Although we wish we could give you a hug upon your arrival, staff and guests are asked to refrain from hugging, shaking hands or touching, at this time.

Masks or other PPE will be made available to any guest upon request.

All guest rooms will be supplied with hand sanitizers and disinfectant wipes.



No contact room service/delivery will be available for all guests for meals prepared by Infinity Restaurant during its hours of operation; Infinity will be open for outdoor and indoor dining with social distancing rules in place.

Advanced check-in and room assignments are now available prior to arrival.

Express check-out is now offered the night before departure.
